**Mr. Steven Amundson  
Orchestra Clinician**

Steven Amundson is in his 33<sup>rd</sup> year on the faculty of St. Olaf College where he serves as Professor of Music and Conductor of the St. Olaf Orchestra. He teaches courses in music theory, aural skills, and conducting. Amundson has held conducting posts at the University of Virginia, Tacoma Community College, and as Music Director of the Tacoma Youth Symphony prior to his arrival to Minnesota in 1981. He is the founding conductor of the Twin Cities' based Metropolitan Symphony, and he served as Music Director and Conductor of the Bloomington Symphony from 1984 - 1997. Amundson has guest conducted professional ensembles in Minnesota including the Duluth Symphony, Fargo-Moorhead Symphony, the Minneapolis Pops Orchestra, and the Saint Paul Chamber Orchestra. He has also been on the conducting staff at the well-known Interlochen Summer Arts Camp, and is in demand as a guest conductor of high school honor orchestra festivals throughout the United States. In the coming two years, Amundson will serve as guest conductor for all-state orchestras in California, Kansas, North Dakota, Ohio, and Pennsylvania.

A commissioned composer and arranger, Amundson is published by the Lauren Keiser Music, the Neil A. Kjos Music Co, and Boosey and Hawkes. Tempo Music Resource distributes his self-published works. His Christmas music, much of it composed for his St. Olaf Orchestra, has been particularly widely performed. His orchestral compositions have received over 700 performances by university, civic and professional orchestras including the Atlanta, Chicago, Colorado, Cincinnati, Columbus, Dallas, Detroit, Houston, Nashville, Oregon, San Diego, St. Louis, and Utah Symphonies, and internationally by the Toronto and BBC Symphonies, and by the Evergreen Symphony in Taipei, Taiwan. His music has been recorded by the Cincinnati Pops Orchestra and the Houston Symphony.

A 1977 graduate of Luther College, Amundson obtained the Master of Music degree in orchestral conducting from Northwestern University and did further studies at the University of Virginia, the Aspen Music School and the Mozarteum in Salzburg, Austria.

In the 1980 International Conducting Competition hosted by the Mozarteum and Austrian National Radio, Amundson placed first earning the *Hans Haring Prize*. In 1992, the Minnesota Music Education Association named him "Minnesota Orchestra Educator of the Year." In the fall of 1995, Amundson received the *Carlo A. Sperati Award* from Luther College in recognition of meritorious achievement in the field of music.



## Dr. Bret Amundson Choral Clinician

Dr. Bret Amundson is the Director of Choral Activities and the Associate Director of General Education at The College of St. Scholastica in Duluth, MN.

At CSS, Bret directs the Concert Choir, *Bella Voce*, Women's Choir, and Vocal Revolution, teaches courses in music education and conducting, and teaches in the school's *Dignitas* program. Under Bret's direction, The College of St. Scholastica

Choirs perform several concerts a year and have toured both regionally and nationally, including the 2013 tour to Rome, Assisi, Subiaco, and Norcia, Italy as a part of The College's Centennial Celebration.

Bret is the Artistic Director of the Lake Superior Youth Chorus, where he conducts the Concert Choir, the Choir Director at Pilgrim Congregational Church in Duluth, and the Artistic Director of the Twin Ports Choral Project. Bret maintains an active schedule as clinician, adjudicator, and guest conductor for choral festivals and conferences in Minnesota and around the country.

Prior to his appointment at CSS, Bret served three years as Vocal Music Director at Cathedral High School/John XXIII Middle School in St. Cloud, MN where he conducted five curricular choirs, two co-curricular choirs, and taught individual voice lessons. In 2007, the Cathedral High School Concert Choir was invited to perform at the Minnesota Music Educator Association's Mid-Winter Clinic. That same year, Bret was awarded the American Choral Directors Association of Minnesota's *Outstanding Young Conductor Award*. From 2005-2008, Bret was the Associate Artistic Director of The St. John's Boys' Choir, where he conducted the Junior Varsity Choir and led the recorder and theory programs.

Bret currently serves on the Board of Directors for the American Choral Director's Association of Minnesota where he is the editor of its *Star of the North* publication. In 2013, Bret received the "Best State Hybrid Website with Professional Designer" award for his work with the *Star of the North*. He sits on the Board of Director's for The St. John's Boys' Choir and is a member-at-large for the NafME Choral Education Council.

Bret currently sings with and directs the Twin Ports Choral Project, and has previously sung with the UW Chamber Singers, and the Twin-Cities based choral ensemble, *Kantorei*. He is an active member of the American Choral Directors Association, the National Association for Music Education, The College Music Society, Chorus America, and the VoiceCare Network.

Bret holds a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Music Education and Vocal Performance from Saint John's University, MN, a Masters of Music in Choral Conducting from Saint Cloud State University, MN, and a Doctorate of Music in Choral Conducting at the University of Washington.



## Dr. Jack Stamp Band Clinician

Dr. Jack Stamp is Professor of Music, Chairperson of the Music Department and Director of Band Studies at Indiana University of Pennsylvania where he conducts the Wind Ensemble and teaches courses in graduate conducting. Dr. Stamp received his Bachelor of Science in Music Education degree from IUP, a Master's in Percussion Performance from East Carolina University, and a Doctor of Musical Arts Degree in Conducting from Michigan State University where he studied with Eugene Corporon.

Prior to his appointment at IUP, he served as chairman of the Division of Fine Arts at Campbell University in North Carolina. He also taught for several years in the public schools of North Carolina. In addition to these posts, Dr. Stamp served as conductor of the Duke University Wind Symphony (1988-89) and was musical director of the Triangle British Brass Band, leading them to a national brass band championship in 1989.

Dr. Stamp's primary composition teachers have been Robert Washburn and Fisher Tull, though he was strongly influenced by his music theory teachers at Indiana University of Pennsylvania and East Carolina. Other studies include work with noted American composers David Diamond, Joan Tower and Richard Danielpour.

He is active as a guest conductor, clinician, adjudicator, and composer throughout North America and Great Britain. His compositions have been commissioned and performed by leading military and university bands across the United States. He has won the praise of American composers David Diamond, Norman Dello Joio, Ron Nelson, Michael Torke, Samuel Adler, Robert Ward, Robert Washburn, Fisher Tull, Nancy Galbraith and Bruce Yurko for performances of their works. He is also a contributing author to the "Teaching Music Through Performance in Band" series released by GIA Publications.

In 1996, he received the Orpheus Award from the Zeta Tau Chapter of Phi Mu Alpha for service to music and was named a "Distinguished Alumnus" of Indiana University of Pennsylvania. In 1999, he received the "Citation of Excellence" from the Pennsylvania Music Educators Association. In 2000, he was inducted into the prestigious American Bandmasters Association. He was awarded the title of "University Professor" for the 2008-2009 academic year at IUP. This is the highest award the university gives to a professor.

He is founder and conductor of the Keystone Winds, an ensemble dedicated to the performance of American band music. Two CD recordings on the Citadel label entitled "Past the Equinox: The Music of Jack Stamp" and "Cloudsplitter" by the Keystone Wind Ensemble with the composer conducting his band works. He is founder and conductor of this ensemble, and also leads them on the Citadel releases, "Night Fantasy: The Wind Music of Robert Ward", "Divertimento: Wind Music by American Composers", "Celebrations", "Wind Visions: The Music of Samuel Adler", "Songs of Abelard", "Pageant", "Cornerstones", and "Out of the Depths". He has also initiated a new series on the Klavier label which boasts three releases which include composer interviews: "The Composer's Voice: The Music of Norman Dello Joio", "The Composer's Voice: The Music of H. Owen Reed", "The Composer's Voice: The Music of William Schuman", "The Composer's Voice: the Music of Alfred Reed", "The Composer's Voice: The Music of Ron Nelson", and the newest release, "Leroy Anderson - The Phantom Regiment and Other Tales".
